INSTALLATION

1. Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.

2. Raise the front of the vehicle until the axle hangs free. Rest the frame on safety jack stands rated for the weight of the vehicle. Removal of the front wheels is optional.

3. Starting on the driver side, remove the existing factory bump stop. Make sure you keep the factory hardware for the installation of the upper bracket.

NOTE: On the passenger side, remove the bolt only; the nut is welded inside the frame.

4. Insert two 3/8-16" Flange Bolts [ITEM F] into the outside holes of the Upper Mounting Bracket [ITEM B] and let it hang freely. Using the factory bump stop bolt and nut, attach the Upper Mounting Bracket [ITEM B] to the bottom of the frame in the same position as the factory bump stop was installed.

5. Bolt upper half of the SumoSpring [ITEM A] to the Upper Mounting Bracket [ITEM B] using the previously installed bolts and tighten securely with a wrench.

6. Attach the Lower Mounting Bracket [ITEM C] to the bottom half of the SumoSpring [ITEM A] in the correct orientation using a single $3/8-16 \times 7/8$ " FHCS [ITEM G]. Please note that the lower mounting bracket must be positioned so that the center hole is offset outward toward the wheel.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Make sure you place a 5/16 Flat Washer [ITEM E] between each of the Lower Bracket Hook [ITEM D] and the Lower Mounting Bracket [ITEM C]. However, if the lower mounting bracket is not tight to the spring plate after the bolts are tightened, you can remove them to ensure a tighter fit.

7. Using the two 3/8-16 x 1 ½" Flange Bolts [ITEM H], two 5/16" Flat Washers [ITEM E] and two 3/8" Locking Flange Nuts [ITEM I], attach two Lower Bracket Hooks [ITEM D] to the Lower Mounting Bracket [ITEM C] making sure to hook them under the shock mount/spring plate.

8. With everything in place, ensure that the top and bottom halves of SumoSpring are visually aligned and tighten the bottom bracket bolts securely.

9. Repeat steps 3 through 8 on the passenger side of the vehicle.

10. Raise the vehicle, remove safety jack stands, and carefully lower vehicle to the hard surface. Remove the chocks in front and back of the rear wheels.

INSTALLATION

1. Park vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind front wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.

2. Raise rear of vehicle allowing the axle to hang freely. Support the frame using safety jack stands. Removing the rear wheels is optional.

3. Attach Upper Mounting Bracket [ITEM B] to the top of the SumoSpring [ITEM A] using two 3/8-16 x ³/₄" Serrated Flange Bolts [ITEM E]. Attach the Lower Mounting Bracket [ITEM C] to the bottom of the SumoSpring using one 3/8-16 x ³/₄" Serrated Flange Hex Bolt [ITEM E] as in Diagram A.

4. Insert two 3/8-16 x 5" Carriage Bolts [ITEM G] into the two square openings in the Lower Mounting Bracket [ITEM C] in such a way that they straddle the factory spring-pack. Position the Lower Bracket so that the curved side finger captures the factory u-bolt.

5. Secure the Lower Bracket [ITEM C] to the factory spring-pack using the U-Bracket Strap [ITEM D] the two 3/8-16 x 5" Carriage Bolts [ITEM G], and two 3/8-16 Top-lock Flange Nuts [ITEM H].

6. Repeat steps 3 through 5 on the opposite side of the vehicle.

7. Jack up the vehicle axle until the Upper Mounting Bracket [ITEM B] is in correct position on frame. Position the bracket so the two lower holes are 6" down from the top of the frame. Using the bracket as a template, drill the lower mounting holes through the frame with a 3/8" drill bit. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Make sure there is clearance on all cables/service lines inside the frame prior to drilling.

8. Insert two 3/8-16 x 1 ½" Hex Bolts [ITEM F] into the lower holes and secure with two 3/8-16 Top Lock Nuts [ITEM H]. **Torque to 30 ft. lbs.**

9. Using the Upper Mounting Bracket [ITEM B] holes as a guide, drill two upper holes using a 3/8" drill bit. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Make sure there is clearance on all cables/service lines inside the frame prior to drilling.

10. Insert two 3/8-16 x 1 ¹/₂" Hex Bolts [ITEM F] into the upper holes and secure with two 3/8-16 Top Lock Nuts [ITEM H]. **Torque to 30 ft. lbs.**

11. Repeat steps 7 through 10 on the opposite side of the vehicle.

12. Carefully lower vehicle. Remove the chocks in front and back of the front wheels.
