

INSTALLATION

1. Park vehicle on level hard surface. Engage emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind front wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
2. Starting on the driver side, locate the brake line bracket on the inside of the frame above the axle.
3. Remove the bolt holding the bracket to the frame.
4. Add the included spacer ensuring the locating pin is located in the hole in the frame and the tab of the bracket locates in the spacer.
5. Add a drop of Blue Thread Locker to the threads of the M8 x 50mm Bolt [ITEM E] and install it through the M8 Flat Washer [ITEM D], brake line bracket and Brake Line Bracket Spacer [ITEM C] and thread into the frame. Torque to 15 ft. lbs.
6. With the vehicle still on the ground (ONE SIDE AT A TIME), loosen the factory u-bolts to allow removal of the factory bump stop.
7. Apply a drop of Blue Thread Locker to threads of the stud on Mounting Bracket [ITEM B] and install the SumoSprings [ITEM A] by turning it tightly on to the stud.
8. Raise the rear of the vehicle to provide sufficient room to install the SumoSprings and support with jack stands.
9. Install the SumoSprings and mounting bracket under the U-bolts.
10. Tighten the U-bolt nuts until snug.
11. Remove jack stands and lower the truck.
12. Re-tighten the U-bolts using factory specifications and procedure.
13. Repeat steps 6 through 12 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
14. Remove wheel chocks.

NOTE: After 200-500 miles of driving, re-torque the u-bolts to factory specifications.

15. Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
